Itinerary:

1st Day: Welcome to Persia!

Landing in Iran Capital, Tehran! Meeting your friendly Tourist Guide and driver to transfer to hotel, overnight in Tehran.

2nd Day: Tehran Tour

Have breakfast in a nice local Café. Then visiting Saadabad Palace Complex, the Royal car museum with Farshchian painting masterpieces. After lunch, Ghazali Cinema Town, knowing about Tehran old times and having a ride with classic cars and meeting the association members. At night walking next to Chitgar lake and have delicious food at Bamland food court.

3rd Day: Tehran

In the morning visiting classic car garage and have a meeting with the chief of Iran national rally federation, then visiting Golestan complex, the royal residential palaces located right in front of Tehran Grand Bazaar. Overnight in Tehran

4th Day: Excursion to Persepolis

Shiraz visiting Quran gate and have a city drive with classic cars. Overnight Shiraz Fly to Shiraz, have an excursion to see the magnificent site of Persepolis and Necropolis, back to

5th Day: Shiraz

City sightseeing in Shiraz, started with NasiralMolk mosque also known as pink mosque. This place is one of the most beautiful mosques of the world and for its roses it's famous as rose mosque too. Walking to Vakil mosque through Vakil traditional Bazaar. Visiting Eram Garden or Hafez Tomb in the afternoon. Overnight in Shiraz

6th Day: Shiraz - Esfahan

Drive to Varzaneh, visiting Varzaneh sandy desert. Do some trekking, Camel riding in desert and enjoy sunset there. Drive to Esfahan, visiting Siosepol and Khaju Bridge Overnight in Esfahan

7th Day: Esfahan

Have a city tour in Esfahan beautiful city. Visiting Vank cathedral in Jolfa Armenian quarter. Getting to know more about Persian music and instruments in Esfahan Music Museum and then have lunch in a nice traditional restaurant. After lunch visiting Naghsh-e Jahan Square the third biggest square in the world! This square was built in Safavid era and meant to be a place for Chogan play, yet Mosques, Palaces and Bazaar were built around it to give it additional value. We'll visit A'li Qapu and Chehel Sotoun palace, Sheikh Lotfollah, Imam Mosques and Bazaar. Overnight Esfahan.

8th Day: Esfahan - Kashan - IKA

The last day of Iran trip, have a transfer with a classic or modern car to IKA airport, however on way, we'll stop to visit Fin Garden, Tabatabaei historical house and Soltan Mir Ahmad Bath.



Payment process:

To start booking process, first we receive your visa documents and apply for your visa.

When your visa is approved, we need to start booking process so a contract including all details about the fee, the payment policy, and cancellation policy will be sent you. You need to sign it and send it back to us in 2 working days.

According to the contract, we need to receive 30% to 50% of the total fee to start booking and the rest will be paid in cash upon arrival.

Cancelation policy:

- If tourist cancels the trip before arrival when everything is booked, tourist must cover actual expenses of the Tour Operator as follow:
 - ✓ 30 days and more before the tour runs,30 % of the whole cost
 - ✓ 30 days to 15 days before the tour runs,60 % of the whole cost
 - ✓ 15 days to 48 hours before the tour runs,80% of the whole cost
 - ✓ Less than 48 hours before the tour runs, 100% of the whole cost
