Itinerary in details:

Day1: Arrival in Tehran

Arrive to Tehran. Meet your friendly guide. Transfer to hotel, have a short rest, then we have a night tour of the famous towers of Tehran, Azadi Tower, and Milad tower!

Based on your interest, you can relax in a nice cafeteria and smoke hookah. Overnight Tehran.

Day 2: Tehran- shiraz

The first place to visit is the main hall of Golestan complex, an amazing palace with more than 440 years history, mesmerizing ornaments and decoration. In 2013 Golestan Palace was selected as a UNESCO world heritage site.

Walking to Tehran Grand bazaar and visiting the Persian Carpet section and having lunch in the famous Moslem restaurant. In the afternoon, we continue our day by going to the northern part of the capital and having a light trekking in Darband or Darakeh to rest a leisure and then have a flight to Shiraz, Overnight Shiraz.

Day3: shiraz

Today after breakfast we drive to the lovely Sepidan district! Sepidan is a four-season destination and there is always something extraordinary and remarkable to do there! In Spring trekking and visiting Nomad is such a great idea and so recommended by our trekking lovers from Hong Kong, in Summer visiting waterfalls and water trekking in valleys is so joyful, in Autumn visiting the Apple gardens and trekking in autumn colored nature and in Winter you can ski in the closest ski resort to the equator!

So based on the time you can do one of these activities, or combine them with horse-back riding, visiting rural regions, schools and have lunch and dinner with a local family.

(Those family tourists who have experienced meeting these local families believe that it has been the highlight of their trip to let their children meet local Iranian children and get to know their living styles). Get back to Shiraz and Overnight in Shiraz.

Day 4: shiraz

Today we to Persepolis, visiting the spring capital of the Achaemenes dynasty. Persepolis or Takhte Jamshid is the remaining royal palaces, tombs, and the ancient city of Parse. Its history date back to 2500 years ago when the first empire of the world was established! Persian Empire! Then visit Necropolis where you visit Royal tombs

After visiting the glory of Persepolis, you will Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant and then return to the Shiraz for overnight stay.

Day 5: shiraz- Tehran

Rise and Shine in Shiraz beautiful city, having breakfast at the hotel and starting our day by visiting the fascinating Nasir Almolq Mosque! Which for the fabulous rose tiles and reputation of pink color is also known as Rose Mosque / Pink Mosque! The golden time to visit the pink mosque is in the morning from 8 to 10 am, when the sunlight passes through colorful glasses in the western praying hall. After visiting Nasir ol Molq Mosque, visiting SahCerah shrine and then walking to the Zand Complex area, passing through the bazaar, and maybe a quick visit of the Vakil bath or the Karimkhan Citadel. Shirazi Ice-cream and Faloodeh are best in the Arg Ice-cream shop, which locates just next to the Karimkhan citadel. After trying the traditional ice-cream or Faloodeh, you're invited to have lunch in one of the best restaurants of Shiraz. After lunch visiting the Mirror Hall of Ali Ibn Hamza Mausoleum. Finally transfer to the airport and leave Shiraz toward Tehran. Overnight in Tehran.

Day 6: Tehran- depart

Today is our last day in Iran and we drive to the IKA airport for departure flight.

. Culinary tour (cuisine):

For dessert, you will eat Flooded Shirazi which is made of noodles, this kind of dessert eat usually with lemon juice or rose water. As the Iranian people like Indian food a lot so if you would like, you could teach us Local food from your country, what is your idea about it?

Payment process:

To start booking process, first we receive your visa documents and apply for your visa.

When your visa is approved, we need to start booking process so a contract including all details about the fee, the payment policy, and cancellation policy will be sent you. You need to sign it and send it back to us in 2 working days.

According to the contract, we need to receive 30% to 50% of the total fee to start booking and the rest will be paid in cash upon arrival.

Cancelation policy:

- If tourist cancels the trip before arrival when everything is booked, tourist must cover actual expenses of the Tour Operator as follow:
 - ✓ 30 days and more before the tour runs, 30 % of the whole cost
 - ✓ 30 days to 15 days before the tour runs, 60 % of the whole cost
 - ✓ 15 days to 48 hours before the tour runs, 80% of the whole cost
 - ✓ Less than 48 hours before the tour runs, 100% of the whole cost
