Detailed Itinerary :

Day 1: Shiraz

Hello Shiraz! Shahre Raaz, meaning the city of Secrets! Today we explore Shiraz, starting from the most beautiful mosque of Iran! The bride of Mosques! Nasir almolk Mosque! The best time to visit this mosque is in the morning and before noon. This mosque was made in Qajar dynasty by a member of Royal family, with precious ornaments and beautiful architecture. Once you get in, you will find yourself in a garden full of roses! After that we'll visit Qavam house and Zinatol molk house, these two Qajarid house are actually a single house! But in two parts! Then we will visit the Vakil Bazaar and Vakil Bath. Overnight in Shiraz.

Day 2: Shiraz

We will start the day by visiting Eram Garden, a beautiful botanical garden with diverse plant species. Next, we will visit the tomb of Hafez, a renowned poet from Shiraz known for his enigmatic poems. The famous German poet Goethe held Hafez in high regard. Following a delightful lunch, we will proceed to Shah Cheragh Shrine. We will spend the night in Shiraz.

Day 3: Shiraz-Isfahan

Explore the ancient treasures of Iran on your ride from Shiraz to Isfahan. Along the way, visit the 2500-year-old Persepolis (UNESCO), Naqsh-e Rostam Necropolis, and the burial place of Cyrus the Great at his Pasargadae (UNESCO). Stop for lunch at a traditional ecolodge to savor unique dishes before continuing on to Isfahan, which is around 360 km away.

Day 4: Isfahan

Explore the breathtaking Islamic architecture of Isfahan, including the UNESCO-listed Naqshe-e Jahan Square with its Sheikh Lotfollah Mosque, Shah Mosque, Ali Qapu palace, Qeysarieh Gate, and the Grand Bazaar. Don't miss the elegant Chehel Sotoun Palace and the 17th-century Hasht Behesht edifice, both UNESCO heritage sites. Immerse yourself in Persian music and instruments at the Music Museum of Isfahan, and enjoy a live performance of Iranian music. In the evening, take a romantic stroll across the Si-o-se-pol Bridge.
