Detailed

Day 1: Tehran

Upon arrival in Tehran, you will be welcomed by your guide. You will visit the Golestan Palace, a UNESCO World Heritage site and a masterpiece of Qajar-era architecture. Next, you will explore the National Museum of Iran, which showcases a rich collection of artifacts from the ancient Persian civilization. In the evening, you can enjoy a traditional Iranian dinner at a local restaurant. You will be staying overnight in Tehran

Day 2: Tehran-Kashan-Isfahan

In the morning you will drive to Kashan and visit the beautiful Fin Garden, a traditional Persian garden with historical significance. Then, explore the Agha Bozorg Mosque, famous for its symmetrical architecture and exquisite tilework. After that, continue to Isfahan, a city known for its stunning Islamic architecture, and spend the night there.

Day 3: Isfahan

For a day tour of Isfahan, visit the remarkable Naqsh-e Jahan Square, one of the largest city squares globally and a UNESCO World Heritage site. You can then explore the Shah Mosque, known for its blue tilework and impressive dome. Next, visit the renowned Ali Qapu Palace, which is celebrated for its high terrace. Finally, enjoy the elegant wooden columns and beautiful murals of the Chehel Sotoun Palace, also a UNESCO World Heritage site.

Overnight in Isfahan.

Day 4: Isfahan-Yazd

Drive to Yazd, which is known for its unique desert architecture and ancient Zoroastrian culture. You can visit the Zoroastrian Fire Temple, where a sacred flame has been burning for over 1500 years. Explore the Towers of Silence, ancient structures used for Zoroastrian burial ceremonies, and discover the Yazd Old Town, narrow alleys, mud-brick houses, and ancient wind towers. Don't miss the Amir Chakhmaq Complex, a prominent structure known for its symmetrical architecture and mosque.

Overnight in Yazd.

Day 5: Yazd-Shiraz

Drive to Shiraz, the city of poets and gardens. Enjoy the drive through the Zagros Mountains with picturesque views of the countryside. Stop by the UNESCO-listed city of Pasargadae, the capital of the Achaemenid Empire, featuring the Tomb of Cyrus the Great.

Overnight in Shiraz.

Day 6: Shiraz

Today you will visit some of the most iconic landmarks in the city. Visit the Nasir al-Mulk Mosque, famous for its stunning stained-glass windows that create a kaleidoscope of colors when the sunlight shines through. Take some time to explore the Vakil Bazaar, a vibrant traditional marketplace with a variety of goods and handicrafts. Then, be sure to visit the Karim Khan Citadel, an 18th-century fortress known for its unique tilework and architecture. Lastly, pay a visit to the tombs of the famous Persian poets Hafez and Saadi, who greatly influenced Persian literature and culture.

Overnight in Shiraz

Day 6: Shiraz-Depart

Visit the beautiful Eram Persian Garden, followed by the tranquil Hafez Tomb. Explore the Ali Ibn Hamza Shrine and mausoleum. Enjoy your final Persian dinner, celebrating the memories of your time in Shiraz. Transfer to the airport for your flight home, marking the end of this memorable journey through Iran.
