



Friendly Iran -10-day Iran Tour







Day 1

•Morning: Start your Nowruz journey by driving from Tehran to Kashan (around 2.5 hours). •Noon: Visit Fin Garden and Borujerdi House, both of which bloom with the energy of spring. •Afternoon: Explore the Sialk Hills. •Evening: Experience Nowruz singing (Noroozkhani) in one of the nearby villages. Overnight: Kashan.

Day 2

•Morning: Head to the enchanting city of Isfahan (about 2 hours). •Noon: Visit Naqshe Jahan Square and Shah Mosque, adorned for Nowruz celebrations. •Afternoon: Enjoy the festive spirit with music and performances at Naqsh-e Jahan Square. •Evening: Stay in Isfahan.

Day 3

•Morning: Visit Chehel Sotoun Palace and Ali Qapu Palace, surrounded by blossoming trees. •Afternoon: Attend Nowruz festivities by the Khaju Bridge, where local musicians gather. •Evening: Spend another night in Isfahan.

Day 4

•Morning: Depart for Yazd (about 3.5 hours). •Noon: Visit Jameh Mosque of Yazd and Amir Chakhmaq Square decorated for Nowruz. •Afternoon: Participate in Yazd's traditional pot-breaking ceremony. •Evening: Overnight in Yazd.

Day 5

Morning: Walk through the scenic Dowlat Abad Garden, reflecting the rebirth of spring.
Afternoon: Join the Chaharshanbe Suri festival (if it coincides with your trip).
Evening: Enjoy the peaceful spring evening in Yazd.

Day 6

•Morning: Start your Nowruz journey by driving from Tehran to Kashan (around 2.5 •Morning: Drive to Shiraz (around 5 hours). •Noon: Visit Eram Garden and the poetic Hafezieh (Tomb of Hafez). •Afternoon: Participate in Nowruz poetry recitations at Hafezieh, a beloved tradition. •Evening: Stay in Shiraz.



Day 7

•Morning: Visit the beautiful Nasir al-Mulk Mosque and Vakil Bazaar. •Afternoon: Explore the ancient ruins of Persepolis and Pasargadae, where the first Nowruz celebrations were held centuries ago. •Evening: Overnight in Shiraz...

Day 8

•Morning: Head to the coastal city of Bushehr (around 4.5 hours). •Noon: Enjoy the fresh air along Bushehr's coastline. •Afternoon: Participate in the lively Dammam drumming and Khonjar ceremony. •Evening: Spend the night in Bushehr, surrounded by the sounds of the sea and celebrations.

Day 9

•Morning: Catch a flight or drive back to Tehran (depending on preference). •Noon: Arrive in Tehran and rest after your travels. •Afternoon: Spend time exploring Tehran's Nowruz markets or Tajrish Bazaar, where you can experience the final days of Nowruz preparations. •Evening: Enjoy a peaceful evening in Tehran and reflect on the beautiful journey.

Day 10

•Morning: Visit Sa'dabad Complex or Niavaran Palace, where the beauty of Nowruz is reflected in the gardens. •Noon: Explore the lively atmosphere of Darband and Darakeh, where locals celebrate the new year by hiking and enjoying nature. •Afternoon: Wrap up your Nowruz experience with a visit to Milad Tower or Azadi Tower, symbolic landmarks of the city. •Evening: Prepare for your departure, taking home memories of an unforgettable Nowruz trip through Iran.
