


Immerse in Iranian Culture

Day 5: Ardabil to Rasht – Entering the Caspian Greenbelt

Drive along the scenic Asalem-Khalkhal road, winding through lush forests and mountain passes. Arrive in Rasht, the capital of Gilan Province, known as the "City of Rain." Discover Rasht's vibrant bazaars and enjoy the unique Gilaki cuisine. The city is a lively gateway to the Caspian Sea region with rich culinary and cultural traditions.

Day 6: Exploring Rasht and Masuleh Village

Spend the day exploring Rasht's historical sites, including its traditional bazaar and charming Shahrdari Square. Take an optional excursion to Masuleh, a breathtaking stepped village perched on the mountainside, famous for its unique architecture and cool climate. Day 7: Rasht to Tonekabon – Forests and Coastline

Head east toward Tonekabon, traveling through Caspian forests and tea plantations. Explore the beautiful Dohezar and Sehezar valleys, famous for their rivers, waterfalls, and lush greenery. Tonekabon offers a serene coastal environment perfect for hiking, fresh seafood, and enjoying nature.

Day 8: Long Drive to Bandar-e Torkaman – Turkmen Cultural Heartland

Travel south-east along the Caspian coastline to Bandar-e Torkaman, entering the land of the Turkmen people. Day 10: Bandar-e Torkaman to Gorgan – Forests and History

Travel a short distance to Gorgan, a city known for its green parks and historical sites. Visit the Gonbad-e Qabus tower, a UNESCO World Heritage Site nearby, and enjoy the peaceful atmosphere of Nahar Khoran Forest Park. Gorgan combines natural beauty with rich Persian-Turkmen heritage.



Day 11: Leisure and Exploration in Gorgan

Take a relaxed day in Gorgan to explore local museums, stroll through the old city, or hike in nearby Golestan National Park. This day offers an opportunity to recharge before your final journey and to connect with the natural and cultural diversity of northeastern Iran.
